

GreenFaith Short Term Organizer Position- Northeast and Mid-Atlantic Faith Organizer

GreenFaith is looking for a skilled organizer to join our team 50%-to-full time to organize clergy and people of diverse faiths to join the People Vs. Fossil Fuels action in DC on Oct 11th-15th, with a specific focus on a multi-faith delegation participating from Oct 11-12th.

The organizer's primary responsibility would be to identify and recruit local leaders in faith based organizations, congregations, leaders to engage and present and pitch their communities to join this important, frontline-led, climate action in Washington, D.C. The organizer would learn and use a variety of tools including, individual meetings, small group meetings, listening sessions and leadership training. After identifying local leaders and building teams within institutions the organizer would be responsible for working with leaders to organize public actions and ongoing support for the Build Back Fossil Free campaign.

Duration: Starting as soon as possible- Oct 31st with the possibility of extension.

Job Responsibilities:

- Organize clergy and communities of faith to attend the People Vs. Fossil Fuels action in DC.
- Identify, train, and recruit key churches, synagogues, mosques, sanghas, temples and other spiritual and religious communities across the Northeast and Mid-Atlantic.
- Identify, train, and recruit religious organizations and coalitions across the Northeast and Mid-Atlantic.
- Conduct presentations in faith communities and organizations about environmental justice and opposing the fossil fuel buildout in the United States - with the goal of recruitment to the DC action.
- Follow up with faith communities to get them involved with Faiths 4 Climate Justice and ongoing GreenFaith activities.
- Turn relational meetings and outreach activities into tangible action and have the ability to recruit 50-100 people as a result of engagement.

Qualifications and Skills:

- At least 2 years of organizing experience or the equivalent is recommended.
- Ability to develop relationships with local leaders of diverse backgrounds and faiths with different experiences.
- Comfort with diverse communities of faith and/or spiritual communities.
- Familiarity with the concept of environmental and climate justice and the need to stop the fossil fuel industry from expanding.
- Sensitivity and/or experience working in diverse coalitions and communities and relationality, especially across race, culture, and religion.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Proficiency in or ability to quickly learn Google suite, Action Network, Control Shift, Salesforce, Zoom, WhatsApp, and peer to peer texting.

- Excellent time management. Can meet deadlines and manage multiple tasks in a fast paced environment.
- Must be self starting and have an entrepreneurial spirit.
- Ability to jump onto a fast-moving train, get up to speed rapidly, and work as part of a team meeting challenging but exciting goals and deadlines
